Judaism

Learn about the religion at the root of Christianity, Islam and modern Judaism. Research the effects of religious persecution and experience a religious festival.




Christianity

Learn about the religion at the core of western society. Attend and report on a Christian church service. Visit an initiation site.




Islam

Learn about the religion that is the talk of the world. Witness a mass pilgrimage, and seek the influence Islam has on a country.



Hinduism

Learn about the most ancient of modern religions. Research life after death and the idea of gods.



Buddhism

Learn about those who follow the Dhama. Develop meditation and examine how religious leaders are found.

Each topic will have end with an assessment: There is a home work research ; A church visit and report; a class library research; and a static image.

You will be evaluated on the standard of your work in terms of task completion, book presentation and your positive contributions.
